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Patshala Rules and Regulations:

- Child must be of age 3 years to enroll in Pathshala as of September 2017. Parents are not allowed to sit in the classroom except Mommy and Me Class whose parents must sit in the class with the kid; parents of Rookies must stay in the building at all times during a Pathshala session. Classes will begin at 10:00 AM sharp. Please make sure your child is in the class on time.
- Parents/guardian should make sure that their child has been admitted into the class prior to leaving the Pathshala location.
- Full attendance is expected since we have only 10 sessions of 2 hrs. per year. Pathshala staff spends considerable time in preparation for the classes; students' absence disrupts the planned curriculum for the entire class.
- Each student must follow the teacher's instructions and class rules when in the class.
- Clean, appropriate and conservative clothing for comfortable sitting must be worn for Pathshala. Socks should be worn since shoes have to be removed and the floor may be cold.
- Each student must complete all homework assignments and bring it to the class to submit to the teacher regularly. If the child is unable to complete the assignment or needs help, parent should personally notify the teacher and ask for help or himself/herself assist the child finish the assignment.
- It is the responsibility of the parents and the student to contact teacher and collect all material as well as assignments for any missed class.
- E-mail addresses will be added to Jain-Boston list to facilitate all Pathshala announcements.
- Every Pathshala is followed by lunch for parents and children. Parents are urged to contact the food coordinator to volunteer for serving and cleanup. Each family is expected to volunteer for at least TWO Pathshala days during the year as well as major events
- To keep enrollment disruption to a minimum, ONLY NEW MEMBERS TO THE JCGB CENTER WILL BE ADMITTED TO THE PATHSHALA ONCE THE CLASSES BEGIN IN Sep 2017.

Please do not email the forms, since the forms have to be signed by parents.

We have read the rules and regulations for the admission of our child to the JCGB Pathshala. We agree on behalf of our child and ourselves that we shall fully comply by them.
